This year's lots include selections from the U.S. and possessions, Canada area, Britain and British Empire, France and Colonies, Germany, as well as general worldwide collections, accumulations and mystery boxes.

Highlights include:

- USA - early issues, revenues, ducks, 2 nice airmail covers, #85B with APS cert, #120, #291, 1c and 2c Parks imperf. sheets of 200
- Great Britain and colonies - nice GB plus classic issues from throughout the British Empire from A (Aden) to Z (Zululand)
- France - early issues, semi's and many Fr colony mini collections
- German area - good singles, states, occupations, Colonies include German and SW Africa
- Worldwide - many choice lots from A (Afghanistan) to Y (Yugoslavia), esp. China and Japan National Parks
- Miscellaneous collections (including 6 vol. Intl collection), accumulation, mixes, covers, etc

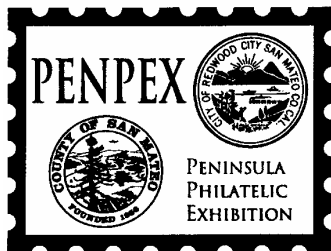

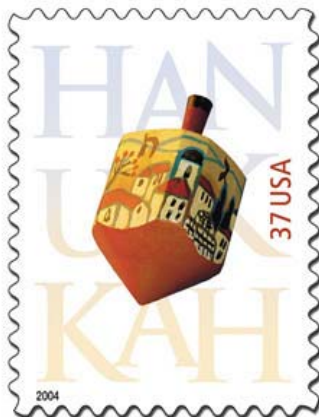

Friends of the Western Philatelic Library

The Friends of the Western Philatelic Library are volunteers who are dedicated to housing, maintaining and expanding the largest philatelic library west of State College, PA. We are located fifteen miles south of Redwood City, in Sunnyvale. The main collection of books, periodicals, pamphlets, tear sheets, stored items, and books for sale, etc. requires over 3,000 lineal feet of shelving, 48 file drawers for unbound periodicals and 30 drawers for pamphlets (with a 15 drawer index)! The computerized catalog lists 4,090 books, 5,500 pamphlets and over 1,400 catalogs, and is expanding weekly!

The WPL was organized as the South Bay Philatelic Library in 1969. By 1971, as the size, importance and mission grew, the name was changed to Western Philatelic Library. Today, it provides in-library use of scarce research books, catalogs, journals, and more common research material. Most material may be borrowed upon presentation of adequate identification.

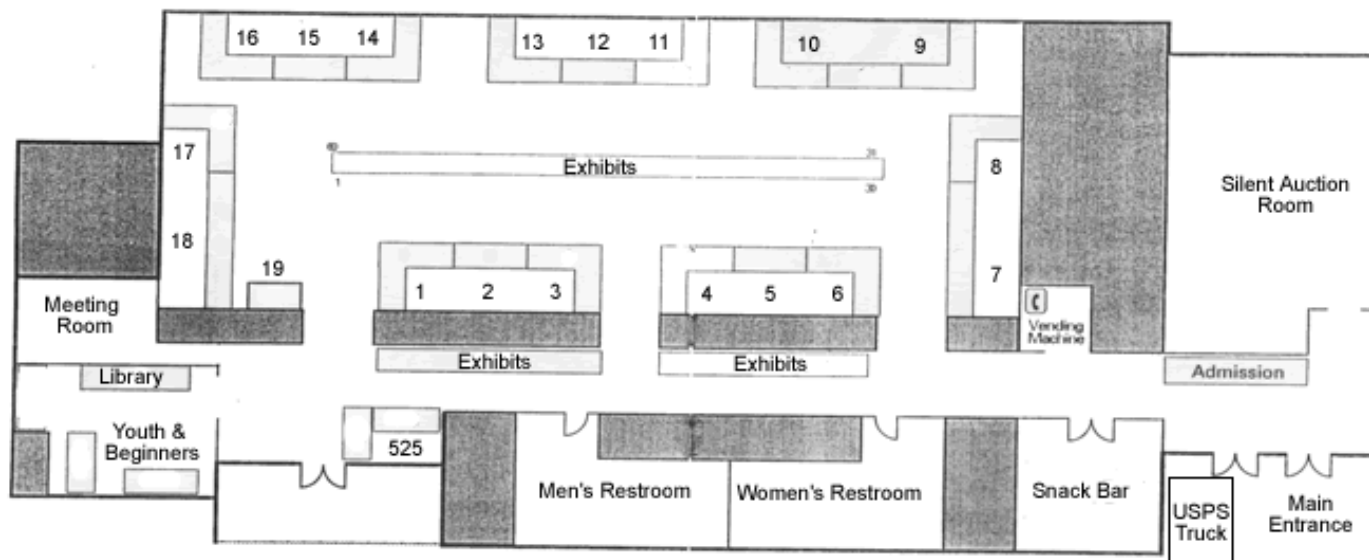
