The Friends of the Western Philatelic Library are volunteers who are dedicated to housing, maintaining and expanding the largest philatelic library west of State College, PA. We are located fifteen miles south of Redwood City, in Sunnyvale. The main collection of books, periodicals, pamphlets, tear sheets, stored items, and books for sale, etc. requires over 3,000 lineal feet of shelving, 48 file drawers for unbound periodicals and 30 drawers for pamphlets (with a 15 drawer index)! The computerized catalog lists 4,090 books, 5,500 pamphlets and over 1,400 catalogs, and is expanding weekly!



The WPL was organized as the South Bay Philatelic Library in 1969. By 1971, as the size, importance and mission grew, the name was changed to Western Philatelic Library. Today, it provides in-library use of scarce research books, catalogs, journals, and more common research material. Most material may be borrowed upon presentation of adequate identification.

The WPL is located in Building 6, Room 6 of the Raynor Park Facility, 1550 Partridge Ave., Sunnyvale, CA. Call (408) 733-0336 for current hours. The library will **have free** give-aways and be selling tear sheets in the main hall.

You are also welcome to just drop in at any meeting.













2008 Covers

The 2008 PENPEX covers, designed by Miriam Thurston, Sequoia Stamp Club member, celebrates the great movie stars of the past. Both designs feature film star USPS postage stamps from the past. The design above is displays the 1993 Silent Star Era stamp series and the 2008 Bette Davis stamp with our special 2008 PENPEX cancellation.

Film diva Bette Davis becomes the 14th inductee into the Legends of Hollywood series on the 100th anniversary of the year of her birth. A consummate actress with a magnetic screen presence, Davis (1908-1989) played a wide variety of powerful and complex roles during her six-decade career. Her riveting performances, acclaimed by critics and fans alike, resulted in 10 Academy Award nominations for best actress; she won twice for her starring roles in *Dangerous* (1935) and *Jezebel* (1938). Artist Michael Deas of Brooklyn Heights, NY, based his painting for the stamp on a black-and-white still of Davis made during the filming of *All About Eve* (1950). The selvage, or margin, photograph is a black-and-white still from *Jezebel*. Deas worked under the direction of Richard Scheaff of Scottsdale, AZ.

Leonard Holmsten

Upon his passing on Thursday, September 4th, 2008, he has been indeed

missed. He was the consummate mentor, helper, and philatelist. There was no time or place where he did not help when asked. Whether it was getting exhibits for a show, as a mentor to a collector (old or new) or aspiring exhibitor, he would always lend a hand.

He was the kind of person that when you met him he became your friend and would reinforce that feeling with every meeting. He would probe and ask questions about your collecting interests and then offer his help if needed. Leonard was truly every philatelist's friend.

As a gold medal exhibitor, he had competed in the Champion of Champions at StampShow 2004 as well as exhibiting international. He was a member of the Collectors Club of San Francisco, Philatelic Society of San Leandro, San Jose Stamp Club, and Fremont Stamp Club where he held most offices at one time or another.

Leonard was a recipient of both the Chaloner Award and the Mae Vignola award, a past president of the Council, and a philatelic judge. He was a past chairman of the Council of Northern California Philatelic Society, COALPEX, and a board member and an honorary director of WESTPEX where he was in charge of security.

His humor is clearly displayed in this year's Court of Honor, Dung Dung Island. The exhibit clearly shows his grasp of rarities, fakes, and postal history but in an amusing way.

Leonard was a great philatelist who gave a great deal to philately and never asked for anything in return. He will be greatly missed.

Leonard Holmsten Council Club Award

The Perpetual Trophy from the CNCPS, also known as the "Leonard Holmsten Council Club Award", will be awarded to the Best Exhibit by a member of a club belonging to the Council of Northern California Philatelic Societies. This year, there will be 15 exhibitors eligible to compete for this prestigious award which is given once per year.

The trophy was first awarded in 1943. After a 22 year absence, it will once again be proudly offered at PENPEX. The winner will be honored by having possession of the award until the next designated Show which will be held in October of 2009.
