Folk Art Eagle #6



The Folk Art Eagle #6 3/4 Water-Activated Gum (WAG) Forever® Stamped Envelope was issued August 9, 2013. This stamped envelope features a photograph of a plaque that shows an eagle carrying two American flags and a shield. Made from pinewood by an unknown carver, the plaque is finished with red, white, and blue paint and appears to have its original gilding.

The eagle has long been associated with patriotism. Since its adoption as our national symbol in 1782, countless artists and artisans have worked eagle motifs into paintings, pottery, furniture, wood carvings, weather vanes, and countless other functional and decorative objects. The Folk Art Eagle Stamped Envelope was designed by art director Richard Sheaff.

Gingerbread Houses

Four new, cheerful holiday stamps capture the delicious tradition and childlike nostalgia of making gingerbread houses. These stamps feature four different gingerbread houses set against a bright blue background. Made with gingerbread and royal icing, each house has sugary fruit slices for shingles, peppermint sticks for support beams, and round, candy-coated chocolate for doorknobs and holly berries, and yet each is unique.

Sally Andersen-Bruce photographed the houses, created by baker Teresa Layman. Art director Derry Noyes designed the stamps which were issued on November 6, 2013.
