



Ed Bierman Memoriam

Ed passed away on May 31, 2019; he was 55 years old. Ed served as a PENPEX Board member and brought much enthusiasm and many great ideas to the show.

He also produced the show program and had just assumed the duties of Exhibits Chair having completed his first year in 2018. He collected old postcards, specializing in those related to San Francisco Cliff House, Sutro Baths, and Redwood City. Ed presented many times at club meetings and exhibited his material at area shows.

Ed was an active member of Sequoia Stamp Club joining in 2000. As the current editor of the club's Stamp Chatter newsletter, he brought color and great articles to the members. SSC selected him as a Life Member of the club in 2016.

He had many other interests including scuba diving, underwater photography, and technology. He worked as the webmaster for Sutter Health for many years, and he maintained the website for PENPEX as well as for the Sequoia Stamp Club and Council of Northern California Philatelic Societies.

Ed was married to his wife, Margaret, for almost 33 years, and they have two adult children, Andrew and Holly. He received a Bachelor's degree in Humanities from Concordia University and a Master's degree in Library and Information Science from San Jose State University.

As a tribute to Ed, we have named the award for the best exhibit of postcards "Ed Bierman Memorial Best Postcard Exhibit Award".

He went too young and is missed by all who knew him.




Location: #18 on Floor Plan Map.


in wonder as Armstrong stepped onto the moon's surface and said "One small step for (a) man, one giant leap for mankind."
