



Did you know that in 1962 and 1965, PENPEX had its own precancel stamps?

In 1965, the $1\frac{1}{2}\phi$ stamp from the Presidential series shown at the left and the $2\frac{1}{2}\phi$ stamp from the Liberty series shown on the front cover were officially precancelled for PENPEX. In 1962, the $\frac{1}{2}\phi$ and $2\frac{1}{2}\phi$ stamps shown on the next page were precancelled. (Both are from the Liberty series.)

Please check-in at the welcome table where all your questions about the show can be answered. If you are one of the first 300 attendees, you will be given a free black mask with the PENPEX logo.








\$2 for 1 ticket, \$5 for 3 tickets, or \$10 for 7 tickets.
